Purpose: To transmit revised Poverty and 70% LLSIL Guidelines.


Background: The Poverty guidelines and 70% Lower Living Standard Income Levels (LLSIL) are used to determine eligibility for WIA Section 167 Programs.


Policy: Effective April 3, 2012 all Florida National Farmworker Jobs Program Projects will use the following revised income levels for eligibility determination.

| Family Size | 70% LLSIL (Metro) Poverty Level |
|-------------|------------------------------------|
| 1 | 11,170 |
| 2 | 15,130 |
| 3 | 19,606 |
| 4 | 24,205 |
| 5 | 28,568 |
| 6 | 33,411 |

For each additional person in a family above six members, add \$4,843 per person. This Bulletin supersedes the Bulletin dated 3/22/2011, which should be retained for reference.
